New Oakley Library can be funded by November 2022

- o New Oakley City Councilmembers request College District Board negotiate about a new Oakley Library with classrooms and computer rooms.
- o With June 2022 College District bond passing, Oakley service groups place a Library bond measure on November 2022 ballot needing just 50%+1 YES votes.
- o College District's large architectural staff and Oakley staff would oversee Library construction.
